Visitor Policy: All visitors must enter the building using the main entrance, Door 1, located at 4950 N. Avers. Visitors must sign in at the security desk and obtain a visitor's pass. The pass must be displayed the entire time the visitor is in the building.

Student Attendance: If your child is absent, please send a note with your child when s/he returns to school. The note should include date of absence, student name, room number, an explanation of cause of absence and parent/legal guardian signature. Excessive tardiness will result in implementing interventions/consequences as outlined in the School Code of Conduct.

BULLY PREVENTION RULES

ALL SETTINGS

- C** Greet others with a smile and wave.
- A** Pick up trash and throw it away in a garbage can.
- R** Use positive language. Always say "please" and "thank you." Respect personal space and property.
- E** Walk quietly in a single file line, facing forward, hands to yourself and one square apart.
- S** Report any problems to your teacher immediately.

ENTRY & EXIT

- C** Hold doors for others.
- A** Be present and on time every day.
- R** Yield the right of way when appropriate.
- E** Enter and exit using the appropriate door.
- S** Always let adult's open doors for visitors coming into the building.

- C** Remain silent during appropriate times.
